



# Small Business Rates Relief



From 1st April 2017 the UK Government revised the criteria for Small Business Rate Relief in England to coincide with the 2017 Business Rates Revaluation. This will allow qualifying ratepayers to receive up to 100% relief on business rate liabilities.

## Small business rate relief

You can get small business rate relief if:

- You are the ratepayer for only one property in England
- Your property's 2017 rateable value is less than £15,000

Contact your local council to apply for small business rate relief.

## What you get

You'll get 100% relief for properties with a rateable value of £12,000 or less. This means you won't pay any business rates at all.

The rate of relief will gradually decrease from 100% to 0% for properties with a rateable value between £12,001 and £15,000.

## If you have more than one property

You can still qualify for small business rate relief if the rateable value of any additional properties is less than £2,900 and the total value of all properties does not exceed £20,000.

The relief is applied against the main property only.
